Tickets are \$18 if purchased in advance or \$20 at the door. Children 3 and under and current Diversity Dancers get in for free. Tickets are good for BOTH the 3:00 and the 5:00 shows so if you have dancers in both shows, you only need to purchase one ticket. Tickets are, however, non-transferable so each person attending will need their own ticket. Tickets for the evening Company Show are sold separately.

Admission is open seating on a first come first served basis, saving of seats is not permitted.

IN STUDIO

Dress Rehearsals



We will NOT be having a dress rehearsal at Faith Chapel. However, we will practice in costumes at the studio the week leading up to the recital. This will take place during usual class times on Tuesday May 26, Wednesday May 27 Thursday May 28 and Friday May 29. Since Monday May 25 is Memorial day, all Monday dancers will have their dress rehearsal on Friday May 29 instead (at their usual Monday class time but on Friday!)

Parents are invited to watch the dress rehearsal. This helps the dancers get used to having an audience. Please use this opportunity to take photos and videos as they will not be permitted during the show. We will also be sharing important information about the show and will be available to answer any questions you might have.

Required HAIR STYLE

This varies per class. Please see the flyer that was in your costume bag for details specific to that class.

Suggested MAKE-UP

It is not required, but we suggest all dancers wear light makeup so their features can be seen on stage (and it makes them feel special!!) Older dancers are welcome to wear heavier makeup if they wish.

Flowers & Puppies

Celebrate your dancer after their big performance! We will be selling flower bouquets and Diversity puppies at the event but will also be offering pre-sales through our online store. This guarantees you that your merchandise will already be there and also saves you from standing in line to purchase. Sign into your parent portal to access the online store! Sales will be available starting May 1st. All items are \$20

Recital Video

All dancers will receive a FREE digital link to recital videos, no need to purchase. The link will be emailed within a couple of weeks. Feel free to share the link with family and friends. Please refrain from taking personal videos. Your dancers would much rather see your smiling face than your phone screen. It is also distracting to other audience members and may block their view.



Dance Photos

Clara Foster Photography will be set up outside to take professional photos of dancers in their costumes. In case of inclement weather we will move the photos to a location inside the church. Please bring cash, check or credit card to pay the photographer directly. If you have 2 costumes or a 2-in-1 costume and wish to have photos taken in both, please take one picture before the show and one after. If you only have one costume you can choose whether to come early or stay after the show for pictures. Photos can be taken at any time between 2:30 and 7:00 with no appointment needed.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE

Please have dancers arrive dressed in costume with hair and makeup done. When you arrive, you will enter through the south doors (on the side of the building facing Central) and check in at the Welcome Desk.

After checking in you can purchase or pick up pre-purchased flowers and bears and then head to the auditorium to find a seat. Dancers will be seated in the audience with their families (no ticket needed)

RECITAL STRUCTURE

Our recitals have a very casual vibe. Dancers are seated in the audience with parents. This helps them feel comfortable before the show and allows them to watch other dancers. Feel free to clap and cheer loudly for your dancers so they feel supported!

Once the show starts, we will call each class up to the stage in turn. They will meet their teacher at the front of the stage and be helped to their spots. After they perform, they will return to the audience.

All "Combo" classes have 2-in-1 costumes. Dancers will perform their tap dance first. When they return to the audience, just remove their shoes and switch their skirt and they will be ready for their next dance!

We try to minimize costume changes during shows (other than the simple shoe and skirt change for combo classes) However, we do have a few dancers with complete changes. We will be reaching out to you individually to share arrangements.

Once the show is over, please leave via the west doors on the front of the building facing Shiloh. This is where the dance pictures will be taken.
